The excursion will start by sightseeing of the Poreč old town, accompanied by a professional tourist guide. In Poreč, we will see the urban structure of the Roman colony Colonia Julia Parentium with two main roman streets Decumanus Maximus and Cardo Maximus, remains of the Roman Forum and the remains of the great temple and the Neptune's temple from the 1st century AD, a Romanesque house from the 13th century, the Gothic complex from the 15th century, the house of two saints from the 15th century, the Gothic Lion Lion from the 15th century, the Euphrasian Basilica complex from the 6th century, the round tower of the 15th century, the 5th-century tower from the 13th century. The guests are invited to gather at 3.00 p.m. in front of Diamant Hotel.

TOURIST INFORMATION



Town of Poreč is located on the western Istrian coast between Mirna river mouths on the north and Limski channel on the south. It has mild climate and coast with plenty of small islands and peninsulas, which are rich with pine trees. The town is protected from seaside by small island of Sveti Nikola. Old city is located on

peninsula surrounded by limestone layer covered by red soil called Poreština. Apparently entire European history passed through Poreč, lat. Parenzo, Parentium. During prehistorically times it was settlement of Histri, from 178 BC it was controlled by Roman Empire, and from 35 BC it was important administrative and economic centre, called Colonia Julia Parentium. During the middle Ages it changes its masters (Celts, Goths, Aquilleian patriarchs, Byzantium, Slavs, Langobards, and Franks) and from 1267 Poreč is governed by Venice. The most important monument of culture was established by Byzantium cathedral of Assumption Mary, better known as Euphrasy's Basilica. It was built by bishop Euphrasy at the place of an older basilica under which Mauro's oratorio layers from 3rd to 4th century AD are located. Shiny mosaics decorating church interior and façade are among the most beautiful remains of Bezan art. UNESCO included in 1997 Euphrasy's basilica in list of World cultural and natural heritage.
